1 Latvia-Estonia national border

Valka and Valga is place which offers unique chance to be in town centre and at the same time in two states - with one leg standing in Latvia, with other in Estonia. In one hand holding saldējums (ice-cream), in other hand - jäätis (icecream). Take a "selfie" right on the border with traffic signs "Here starts Latvia" and "Here starts Estonia". Watch, where do ice-cream melts faster - at North of Latvia or at South of Estonia. Listen, do frog s of Varžupīte (Frog river) croacking in Latvian or Estonian language.

2 Valka Local History Museum

Jānis Cimze started the first seminary for Vidzeme parish schoolteachers at the 19th century, on the site where the museum now is. Many famous figures of Latvian and Estonian culture and education were educated at this seminary. Due to the museum's historical location, it seeks to popularize the work of Jānis Cimze, who was a pedagogue and a founder of the Latvian choir singing culture, as well as that of his pupils. It also aims to promote public interest and knowledge concerning

3 Valka-Lugaži Evangelical Lutheran Church, observation tower

The first written record of the church dates from 1477. The church is in the basilica style, and has a simple appearance, indicating that it must have been the peasants' church in earlier times. 5 Valga Military Theme Park

Come and learn about the Paiu Battle of the War of Independence on the site where the battle took place. Or would

you like to learn more about the past and present of national defence in Estonia? The Military Theme Park includes military vehicles, armoured vehicles, a tank, a bunker of Forest Brothers, a large collection of weapons and many other items. You can test your shooting skills on the shooting simulator.

The Theme Park was founded on the initiative of border quards on the premises of the Valga Border Guard Region and was opened in 2000.

6 Town Hall

Built in 1865, the late Neoclassical Valga Town Hall (Raekoda) stands on the city's central plaza, which was formerly a market square. The first ethnic Estonian mayor in the country's history, the pharmacist Johannes Martson, governed the city from 1902–1917. A memorial plaque commemorating his dedication to the Estonian national cause can be seen on the wall of the Town Hall's foyer. A wax figure of Martson can also be found in the Valga Museum. From 1917–1918, the city had a Latvian mayor, Kārlis Aleksandrs Ozoliņš In 1917, the Latvian Provisional Government adopted a

declaration in Valga Town Hall, proclaiming Latvia autonomous. Kesk tn 11, Valga 57°46'35", 26°01'52"

✓ Valga Jaani (St John's) Church

Jaani Church, located right in the heart of the city, was built in 1816 according to the design of architect Christoph Haberland and it is the only church in Estonia with an oval ground plan. The unique organ has been preserved in its original shape and it is the only instrument built by Friedrich Ladegast still left in Estonia. Interesting facts: the organ is one of the 200 best organs in Europe. Music can be heard from the church's bell tower at midday and midnight. Kesk tn, Valga, +372 5031474, 7661820
